

READ BEFORE PLASTERING

- Finish the HW-frames like normal drywall systems.
- Finish the ST-frames like regular plaster finishing.
- Use glass fiber mesh tape on the joints.
- Only install the frames when the construction is completely windproof!
- Do not use excessive water or do not moisture the frames excessively.
- Avoid (yellow) StucPrimer on the visible part of the frames.
- The front-side of frames can be used as reference surface when plastering. Keep visible contour / edges clean at all time!
- In case of uneven ceilings or walls or when thick layer of plaster must be used:
 - First plaster the wall or ceiling and keeping the frame untouched.
 - Let it dry.
 - Check the position of the frame and fine-tune if necessary.
 - Plaster up to the border of the frame and finish.
